Application for admission to Squirrels Nursery (2-3 years)

- In order to be considered for a Squirrels Nursery place this form must be returned to the school. Please read the Squirrels Admissions policy before completing this form (available on the school website or from the school office). Please note:
- Completing this form does not guarantee an offer of your preferred choice or of a place.
- There is no deadline for applications to Squirrels nursery and applications will be considered on receipt, but Places will not generally be offered more than one school term in advance.
- If you are offered a non-FEET funded place in Squirrels, you will be asked to pay a £100 deposit upon acceptance of the place. The deposit will be set off against your first bill. If your child fails to start Squirrels on the agreed date, the deposit will be retained by the school.
- **Children attending Squirrels nursery do not have automatic entry to Acorns nursery. It is your responsibility to ensure you are aware of the Acorns admissions criteria. Normally, children who have not attended Squirrels but who live 2km or less from the school have priority over children living more than 2km from school (see website for details). The distance is measured using the Surrey County Council mapping database.**
- If you believe you are entitled to FEET funding you must provide confirmation before a funded place can be offered – see [link here](#) for details of how to apply.
- If you believe you meet the criteria for 30 hours free entitlement for 3-4 year old children, you must obtain an 11-digit eligibility code from HMRC - see [link here](#) for details of how to apply. We need this code before we can offer a 30 hour place in the nursery.

Additional information needed for children claiming 30 hours free childcare

The Government has currently indicated eligible families are those where both parents are working, or the sole parent is working in a lone parent family, and each is earning on average a weekly minimum wage equivalent to 16 hours at National Minimum or Living wage, (i.e. equating to about £5,500 per annum) and less than £100,000 per year. All children who receive the extended free entitlement provision at Squirrels Nursery for up to 15 additional hours per week are allocated a core offer of 15 hours (which may be in Acorns Nursery rather than Squirrels Nursery) which will be reverted to in the event of a child's eligibility for this entitlement ending. At this point in time parents will either have the option to directly fund the additional up to 15 hours per week themselves (refer to the Terms and Conditions document) or reduce their child's nursery provision to the core offer of 15 hours. **Note:** Core offer session days will be the Acorns sessions (where applicable), where the child does not attend Acorns the core sessions will be agreed at the time the change needs to be made.
