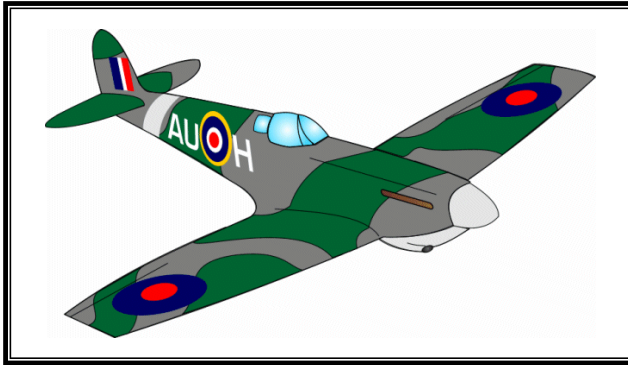


# Year 6 Curriculum Overview – Spring Term
