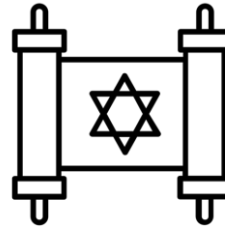


What is the Torah and why is it so important to Jewish families?

What have I already learned to help me?








If I am in Year 2 -

Judaism is the religion of the **Jewish people**.

The **synagogue** is the place where the **Torah** is kept and where Jewish people go to pray.

The **Torah** is a scroll and is written in Hebrew.
