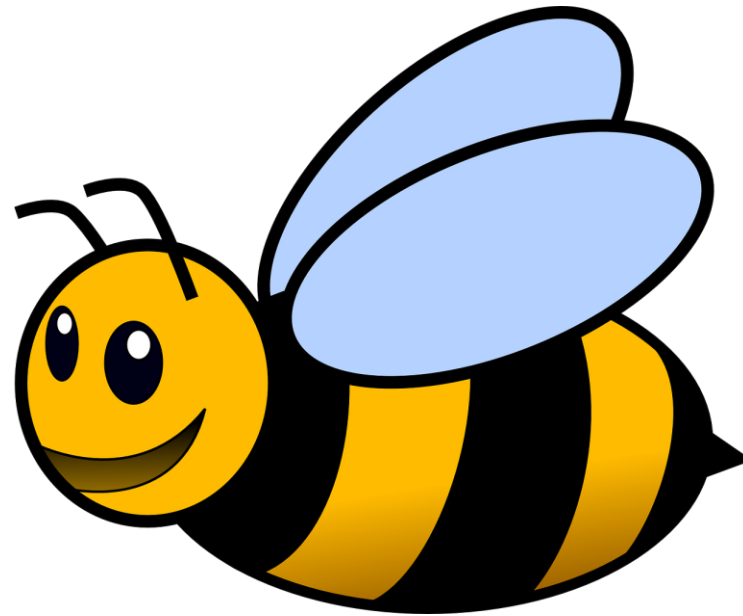
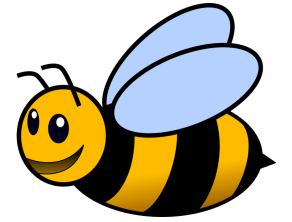

PE

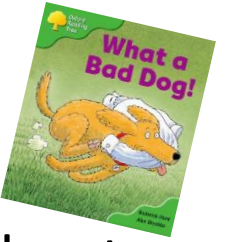
- PE is every Tuesday and Friday
- Children arrive in school wearing PE clothes and trainers.
- They wear their PE clothes all day
- NO earrings – Please remove or tape on PE days.
- Clubs- Children can either wear PE kit all day or bring it in to change.

Lunch time...

- All children can have school lunches. Lunches can be chosen via Scopay each week.
- Children with allergies/dietary requirements are known by the kitchen staff.
- Children's eating habits are monitored and we will let you know if there are any worries.
- Children can take as long as they need to eat their lunch.
- Children are encouraged to learn how to use knife and fork. Help is given to cut up food if needed.
- Children go onto the playground when they have finished their meal. Reception staff are outside.
- Children may bring a packed lunch although school dinners are encouraged.
- If children have a packed lunch, they must adhere to our Healthy Lunchbox policy. (ask at reception). They do not need a drink with their packed lunch – water is provided.



Reading...



- Children will take home 2 reading books each week and will read with an adult at least once a week in school.
- Children will also bring home an additional picture book which they have chosen to read with you, the parents/carers.
- Children all have a reading diary which we expect parents/carers to complete each week to give us an indication of how your child is reading at home.
- We expect children to read at least 3 x weekly at home.
- These books do not replace bed time story!

It is vital that children continue to listen to bed time stories as part of their bedtime routine, to develop their love of reading and to support their language development.

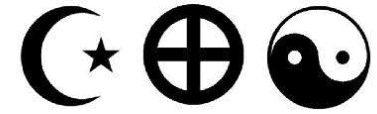
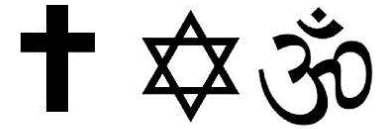
Do you have an area of expertise or a hobby?
