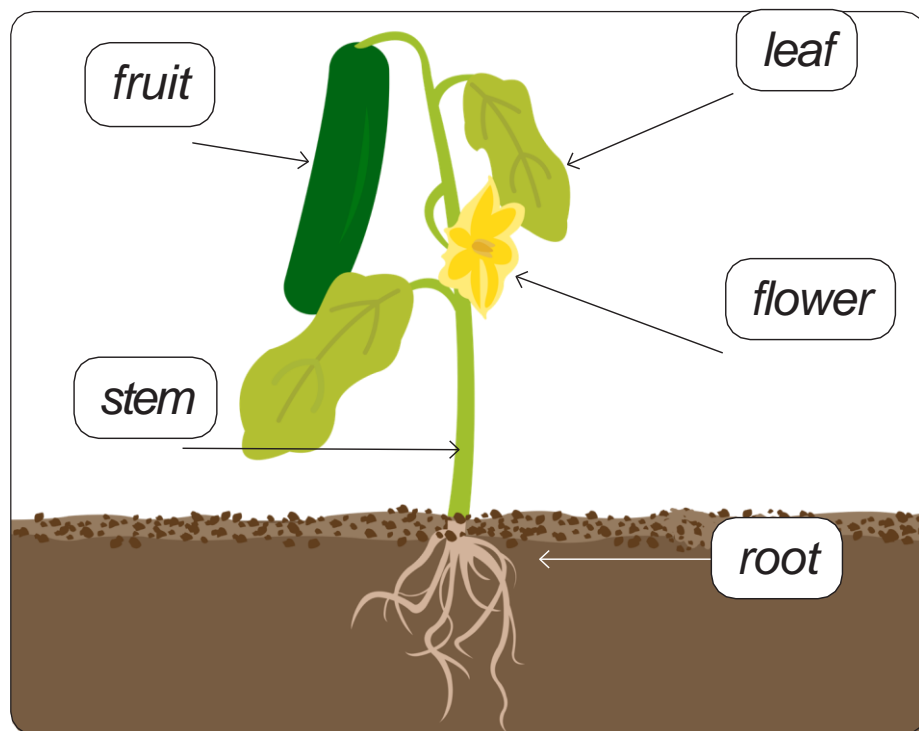
Types of plants

Plants have five main parts.

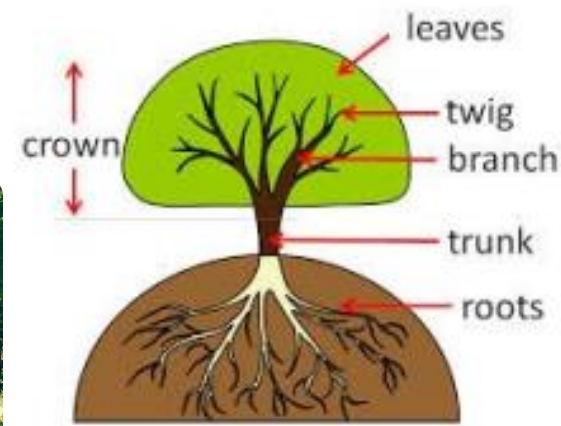


Trees

petal	Thin, brightly coloured or white part of the flower.
fruit	Fleshy part of a plant that contains seeds or a stone.
root	The part of the plant that grows under the ground.
branch	Part of a tree that grows out from the trunk.
twig	a smaller woody shoot growing from a branch of a tree
bark	The outer covering of a tree trunk
stem	The upright main stalk of a plant.
trunk	Large main stem of a tree.
sort	Group into a type
identify	Work out what something is.
